A valuation has been drawn up and we await approval from DCC. 11-0724 To receive an update on the creation a community woodland walk on a piece of land owned by DCC in Sherburn Hill: Work has started on the project. The grass has been cut and a walkway path has been laid. There are areas that require fencing and Taylormade are donating the timber. Cllr Thompson is looking into a lantern parade for September/October. We would like volunteers to help plant and we will sow a wildflower meadow.
